AWSA-Be

AWSA-Be is a feminist, secular organisation, independent from any political or religious affiliation. AWSA-Be advocates for equality between women and men and fights against the stereotypes faced by women from the Arab world.

The gaals of the organisation are the promotion of the rights and the improvement of the situation of women from the Arab world, whether they reside in their country of origin or in another country, whether they are newcomers or belong to the second or even third generation.

Lebanese-Moroccan feminist activist, doctor of law specialized in criminal law, student lawyer in a law firm, Noura Raad is also member of the board of the French Coordination of the European Women's Lobby (CLEF) and co-president of the European Network of Migrant Women. She is committed to the fight against violence against gwomen and girls and for women's access to justice.



Hanane Hajj Ali is a prominent cultural and artistic figure in Lebanon and the Arab world. In addition to her work as an actress, playwright, writer and director since 1978, she is a theater studies teacher. Hanane is also founder and board member of several cultural organizations such as Culture Resource (Al Mawred Athaqafy). She received the Gilder / Coigney Prize awarded by "The League of Professional Theater Women".

Rules, terms and conditions of the photo contest FROM 18 YEARS OLD

1. Organization of the photo contest

This competition is organized by Arab Women's Solidarity Association – Belgium (AWSA-Be) The judging of the contest will be conducted by a panel of external experts. The decision of this jury are final.

2. Terms and conditions to participate in the contest

- The contest is opened to all Lebanese living in Lebanon.
- Participation in this contest is free.
- The contestant declares to have read and to respect these rules, terms and conditions. The nonobservance of the rules will automatically disqualify the contestant from the competition.
- Photo submissions must be original photos created by the contestant and must not contain any elements that are protected by someone else's copyright or otherwise subjected to third party proprietary rights, including privacy and publicity rights. Indeed, by submitting a photo to the contest, the contestant affirms that he or she has obtained written consent from all individuals whose image or likeness appears in the photo and further affirms that he or she is prepared to provide reliable documentation to that effect upon request.
- Photo Submissions must not contain calls or incitement to violence, racism... Submissions also must not contain content or images that could be considered abusive, inflammatory, denigrating, or disrespectful and must be in conformity with the Universal Declaration of Human Rights. Pictures whose content goes against the Universal Declaration of Human Rights will be directly eliminated, and any other application of the participant(s) will be refused.

3. Topic of the contest : " Lebanese women, united in diversity"

- With this contest, AWSA-Be wants to **promote the Lebanese women from different places of the country in order to talk about and to show the diversity of Lebanese women** and their different life paths in society. AWSA-Be wants to encourage the contestants to think about Lebanese women, their different backgrounds, the situation they are living and their commitments and needs.
- The selected photos will be used for an exhibition which will aim at promoting the positive and active role of women in Lebanon and to break stereotypes towards them.

4. Presentation of pictures and comments

- Each Contestant may submit up to three photographs or three sets of up to five photographs. By sets, AWSA-Be means a set of pictures with a link between them. Each picture from a set needs to be numbered. Photographs can be film or digital (the resolution will be min. 300 dpi), in black and white and/or in color. Digital photographs should be taken at the highest resolution possible in order to be used for the exhibition.
- The formats used for pictures are free.
- Photographs must be accompanied by a commentary and a title. The comments are directly related to the pictures shown and aim to tell their story. They can be written in French, English or Arabic.
- Each photograph will be accompanied with the details of the contestant (address, phone, email address, postal address, date of birth).
- Comments must be personal creations (no recovery of texts or poems).

5. Deadline for submitting photographs and comments

Photographs should be submitted before midnight (Belgium Local Time) 30th of August 2021 by email at: awsabe@gmail.com

6. Uses of the photographs

- The 30 photographs selected will be exhibited in October 2021 in the City Hall of Brussels.
- AWSA-Be will be allowed to use the photographs for the work of the organisation (exibhition, pedagogical tools, etc.). In addition, 12 photos will be highlighted in AWSA-Be 2022 calendar.
- All photos submitted will be the property of AWSA-Be and will therefore possibly be used for the purposes of the organisation. AWSA-Be will include the photographer's name for every use of the photography.

7. Announcement of results and awards

- The jury will select 30 pictures. Images will be judged on originality, technical excellence, composition, overall impact and artistic merit. The jury's decisions are final.
- A symbolic surprise gift will be offered to all participants of the contest. Then, based on a scoring and counting of points, three prizes will be awarded:

1st prize: 500 € 2nd prize: 400 € 3rd prize: 300 €

- Only one prize per contestant will be awarded.
- Winners will be contacted personally by AWSA-Be by phone or email, unless the contestants explicitly refuse it, their names will be published on the website of AWSA-Be and in the annual report of 2021.
- All winning photographers will have their photos exhibited during the AWSA-Be event in Brussels in October 2021. A vernissage will take place with artists, photo editors, media, associations, etc. This will be followed by dissemination of the winning pieces to the cultural and associative circles in Brussels.

1. Organization of the photo contest

2. Terms and conditions to participate in the contest

- The contest is opened to all Lebanese living in Lebanon aged between 18 and 25 years old
- Participating in this context is free.
- All texts presented to the contest must be originals. They can be written in French, English or Arabic.
- Participants agree to obide by the rules of the contest, otherwise they will be disqualified.
- Participants have knowledge of the Universal declaration of human rights and will respect it in the context of this contest. Any text promoting values that are against human rights will be disqualified.

3. Theme of the contest

- Theme of the contest: **« Secularism and diversity in lebanon, finding a new perspective and building bridges for togetherness ».**
- Format: free form dissertation, slam, de poem, article with a maximum of 9000 signs (spaces included) to be sent in pdf format at: awsabe@gmail.com

A symbolic surprise gift will be offered to all participants of the contest. Then, based on a scoring and counting of points, three prizes will be awarded:

1st prize: 500 € 2nd prize: 400 € 3rd prize: 300 €

Only one prize per contestant will be awarded.

Winners will be contacted personally by AWSA-Be by phone or email, unless the contestants explicitly refuse it, their names will be published on the website of AWSA-Be and in the annual report of 2021.

The winning texts will be used to promote Lebanese women's rights in Belgium and in the Arab world.
